Range Updates

We had a very successful work day on April 20. Thanks to the organization of Frank Zuppo and Matt Bassman, we were able to knock out a lot of work in a relatively short period of time.

Here are some of the improvements made on April 20.

- New broadhead targets these targets intentionally do not have bullseyes/shooting faces so you can place your preferred shooting spot on the target. Please remove your shooting spot when you are finished.
- Multiple new 3D targets, including a new Grizzly target at the cliff shot.
- Fixed door on the ground blind PLEASE CLOSE THE DOOR after you shoot from the blind so the door doesn't blow off again!
- Added targets to the kid's range.
- Added a natural ground blind above the two elk at the bottom of C loop.

If you missed the April 20 workday, you still have time to join the fun on May 11! We will be adding marked distances at the practice ranges, signing the kid's range, repositioning some bow rests on the 3D range and continuing trail improvement work that was started on April 20.
